## PUKA WHAKAATU HIAHIA - EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

### Ngāti Rangī Nominee – Tongariro-Taupō Conservation Board

Te Tōtarahoe o Paerangi (**Te Tōtarahoe**) is the governance entity for Ngāti Rangī established for Ngāti Rangī's Treaty settlement.

Te Tōtarahoe is calling for expressions of interest (EOI) from suitably experienced and interested Ngāti Rangī uri who wish to be considered for appointment to the Tongariro-Taupō Conservation Board.

Rukutia Te Mana, Ngāti Rangī's Deed of Settlement with the Crown, provides for the Minister of Conservation to appoint, on the nomination of Te Tōtarahoe, a member to the Tongariro-Taupō Conservation Board.

The position is for a term of three years. The position is an interim position pending the outcome of collective negotiations relating to Tongariro National Park (which are yet to commence) or the conclusion of all Whanganui iwi settlements in the Tongariro-Taupō Conservation Board area.

The Board meets up to six times a year, and nominees must be available to fulfil the requirements of the role. Further information about the work of the Conservation Board can be found here:

## 1. Ngāti Rangitanga

- An appreciation of Ngāti Rangī's kawa, tikanga and ritenga, Te Ara ki te Moungaroa 2035 (Ngāti Rangī's intergenerational strategic plan) and Rukutia Te Mana (Ngāti Rangī's Deed of Settlement).
- The ability to articulate and make decisions within the context of Ngāti Rangī's kawa, tikanga and ritenga, Te Ara ki te Moungaroa 2035 and Rukutia Te Mana.

## 2. Te Ao Tūroa

- A record of advocacy and interest in te ao tūroa.
- An appreciation for Ngāti Rangī's Taiao Management Plan and priorities in te ao tūroa.

To be considered, please apply in writing with the following information:

- A brief CV (4-page maximum) setting out contact details, relevant knowledge, experience, skills and qualifications for the role; and
- A brief Candidate Statement outlining how you might fulfil the requirements of the role, grounded in a Ngāti Rangī perspective (400 word maximum).
